Call for applications for the selection of young singers
for the awarding of scholarships for the Masterclass on
Dramma per Musica “L'Olimpiade” by Antonio Vivaldi

Performances: 21 and 22 February 2026
at the “Mario del Monaco” Theatre in Treviso

From 3 February to 22 February 2026

From 3 to 14 February 2026, at the **Fondazione Giorgio Cini** (Venice), and from 15 to 20 February at the **Teatro Comunale “Mario del Monaco” in Treviso**, there will be a special session of the Accademia Vivaldi, led by soprano Gemma Bertagnolli and aimed at staging Antonio Vivaldi’s musical drama “L’Olimpiade”.

“L’Olimpiade” will be performed at the Teatro Comunale “Mario del Monaco” in Treviso on 21 February 2026 at 11 a.m. and on 22 February 2026 at 4 p.m., conducted by Francesco Fanna and directed by Fabio Condemi.

The diapason will be set at 440 Hz.

Attendance is mandatory for the entire period.

The cast will be decided during the masterclass.

At the sole discretion of the committee, **ten candidates will be selected** for the following roles:

- **Aminta (Soprano)**
- **Megacle (Soprano/Mezzo-soprano)**
- **Aristea (Mezzo-soprano/Contralto)**
- **Argene (Mezzo-soprano/Contralto)**
- **Licida (Mezzo-soprano/Contralto)**
- **Clistene (Tenor)**
- **Alcandro (Bass)**

Completion of application forms and related documentation

Candidates must complete the application form and send it by email to segreteria.vivaldi@cini.it, attaching the following documents:

- detailed *curriculum vitae*;
- copy of an identity document;
- link to a video recording of the performance of two musical pieces by Antonio Vivaldi, preferably from “L’Olimpiade”.

Deadline for submission of applications

Applications must be sent no later than midnight on 14 December 2025.

Scholarships

Each successful candidate will receive a **scholarship** covering the costs of enrolment and attendance at the Masterclass. They will also be provided with accommodation from 2 to 23 February 2026, lunches from 3 to 22 February 2026 and a gross expense allowance of €1,000.

Personal data
